## **PURPOSE OF THE STUDY**

The purpose of this research study is to determine whether existing measures of forgiveness and related concepts, which have been created and used mainly in Western cultures, can be adapted for use in the South African context. You are being asked to participate in this study because you are 18 years of age or older, can read, speak English and are a South African resident who identifies with the local community.

#### DESCRIPTION OF THE STUDY AND YOUR INVOLVEMENT

In this study you will be asked to complete a survey at three different times. For the first survey, you will complete several demographic questions such as your age, gender, and religious affiliation, and questions about your thoughts and feelings on forgiveness and areas related to it (e.g., social harmony). The second and third surveys will be completed approximately 6 and 12 months after the first survey. You will again complete a set of questions about areas related to forgiveness during each of those surveys. Each survey will last about 20-25 minutes. If you decide to be in this research study, you will be asked to consent to participate in this study by

selecting "I choose to participate in this study", after you have had all your questions answered and understand how you will be involved.

All of your data will be kept strictly confidential and will be viewed by the research study personnel only. You do not have to answer any questions you do not wish to answer or participate in any activities you do not wish to, and you may withdraw from the study at any time without penalty.

#### **RISKS AND DISCOMFORTS**

The risks are no greater than the risks associated with daily living. However, if participating in this study causes you to feel the least bit uncomfortable, you can skip any of the questions, stop participating in the study or refuse to participate in the study altogether. If participating in this study causes you to feel upset or you become concerned about your psychological state, the study staff will provide you with contact information for resources available that can help you address these issues, including:

If you complete the third survey, which will take place 12 months after completing the first survey, you will be entered into a lottery draw to win one of 50 Visa e-gift cards valued at R400 each. Winners of each lottery draw will be notified of such via email or telephone.

#### COSTS

There are no costs for participating in this study other than the time you will spend taking the study.

#### **ALTERNATIVES**

The alternative to participating in this study is to not participate.

### **CONFIDENTIALITY**

The data collected in this study will not be personally identifiable, as no name, birth date, or other potentially identifiable information will be matched with your

responses. Data are being collected only for research purposes. All information will be kept in password protected electronic files. Electronic files of the study data will be kept indefinitely. Access to all data will be limited to study personnel.

We will not tell anyone the answers you give us; however, information from the study may be looked at or copied for research or legal purposes by the University of Pretoria.

What we find from this study may be presented at meetings or published in papers, but your name will not ever be used in these presentations or papers.

#### **VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION AND WITHDRAWAL**

You do not have to participate in this study. If you choose to participate, you may stop at any time without any penalty, loss of care, service or benefits to which you are otherwise entitled.
